

OSSCA EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING 7/28/02

MINUTES

1. Treasurer's Report:

2. Unified Dues:

Remember that we have gone to a unified dues structure beginning this season. Local, state, and national dues are all due by September 15th, 2002. However, since the 15th is a Sunday, your payment must be postmarked by September 14th, 2002.

The NSCAA has realigned the voting regions for the national poll:

Boys:

Ohio used to be in a region with Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri and Wisconsin...a total of 2,086 teams. Since the OSSCA has gone to a unified dues structure with the NSCAA, Ohio is now in a region with Indiana and Kentucky...a total of 935 teams, 524 of which are from Ohio.

Girls:

Ohio used to be in a region with Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Minnesota, and West Virginia. Since the OSSCA has gone to a unified dues structure with the NSCAA, Ohio is now in a region with Indiana, Iowa, and Minnesota...a total of 760 teams, 368 of which are from Ohio.

Suggestions presented by Pat Schymanski:

- Recommend one fee for both days. Reason attendance is growing with better clinicians. Expenses are fixed or in case of insurance, based on highest attendance. Clinician's expenses could grow. More predictable income would make budgeting easier and also, the decision on paying for clinicians.
- We should keep on-line registration.
- Have each District President supply self-addressed envelopes for clinic mailing. About 200 coaches do not get invited every year due to poor, missing, or wrong addresses.
- Invest in coaching gift, \$20 gives nice gifts and increases attendance.
- Invest about \$300-\$500 in door prizes, especially Saturday. Helps a lot.
- Pay the hotel bill with the credit card to keep expenses in line with accounting year.
- Note: the treasurer did a great job of working with me to pay expenses timely.
